We have also been in touch with the landowner asking for him to make a definite decision as to his original proposed Diversion near to Quoit Farm. Once we have an answer from the landowner, it will then be a matter of liaising with County Farms to remove all the obstructions in the hedge rows and then place board walks over the marshy areas." b. <i>Notice (Form 1)</i> – Committee to consider any response from CCC, to Mr Harris's request that the Local Highway Authority removes the obstruction on footpath no.20, in accordance with the 1980 Highways Act Section 130a(1).
